Online HAZWOPER 16-Hour All Industries

Intended Audience

This 16-hour course is intended for professionals with 24 hours of previous HAZWOPER training. Specifically, the following workers are required by OSHA standard 29 CFR 1910.120, paragraph (e)(3)(i) to reach 40 total hours of HAZWOPER training:

- 1. Those who are likely to be exposed to hazardous materials over the permissible and published exposure limits
- 2. Those whose work regularly requires the use of respirators
- 3. Supervisors and managers who are directly responsible for overseeing workers engaged in hazardous waste operations

NOTE: Paragraph (e)(4) has additional training requirements for these professionals. This course is not intended for those without 24 previous hours of HAZWOPER training. Instead, these professionals can opt to take our HAZWOPER 24-Hour for All Industries Course to achieve the necessary prerequisite certification or our HAZWOPER 40-Hour for All Industries Course. Course Topics

OSHA requires varying levels of HAZWOPER training depending on the workload of different professionals. This course covers the following topics that build on those outlined in the prerequisite course:

- Medical surveillance
- Respiratory protection
- Exposure monitoring
- Personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Hazardous substances as defined in EPA and DOT standards 40 CFR 261.3 and 49 CFR 171.8

- Emergency response, including hazardous materials response (HAZMAT)
- Excavations

NOTE: Students must have completed a HAZWOPER 24-hour course as required by the OSHA standard 29 CFR 1910.120 before taking this course.
