OSHA Title 29 Code of Federal Regulations and the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) are introduced in this course as well. Every EAP must include means of reporting emergencies, evacuation procedures and escape routes, procedures for those who remain behind, procedures to account for all employees, rescue and medical duties and persons who may be contacted for details. The job site must have an alarm system that contains a bell, horn, siren or voice announcement system to alert workers of an emergency
